Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Secretary, Mizoram Legislative Assembly letter No. SLA. /77/11 dated the 11th January, 1977 on the above subject and to say that the existing entries against Sl. No. 28 of the Annexure to this Ministry's

letter No. 14025/11/75-MZ dated 26th April, 1976 may be deleted and subsequent entry No. 29 may be re-numbered as 28.

It may, however, be mentioned that if the Government of Mizoram desire to give a higher scale (i.e. Rs. 550-900) for future recruits of the post of Librarian in the Mizoram Legislative Assembly, they may in the first instance, have to revise the recruitment rules for this post in accordance with the recommendations of the Third Pay Commission.
