No. MBSE/Estt. 18/77/8, the 11th Aug. 1977. Applications are invited from suitable candidates for filling up the under-mentioned Temporary Posts under the Mizoram Board of School Education :—

1. Academic Officer :— (1) No. of Posts — 1 (one.)
  - (2) Pay Scale— 900-40-1,100-(EB)-50-1400/- p m. plus all allowances admissible to Govt. servants in Mizoram.
  - (3) Qualifications require :—
    - (a) At least 2nd. Class Master's Degree with Post Graduate Degree or equivalent diploma in Education/Teachers' Training.
    - (b) Not less than ten years experience of teaching in Secondary Schools/ Colleges.

(c) Preference will be given to candidates with expert knowledge of curriculum construction and organisation of Seminars and work shops.

(d) Working knowledge of Mizo is qualification

(4) Age—Candidate should not be less than 35 years of age. No age restriction in case of persons already in Government service.

**2. Asst. Academic Officer.**

(1) No of posts—3 (three.)

(2) Pay scale — 700-40-900-(EB)-40-1100 50 1,300/- p.m. plus all allowances admissible to Govt. servants in Mizoram.

(3) Qualifications required —

(a) At least 2nd. Class Master's Degree with Post Graduate Degree or equivalent diploma in Education/Teachers' Training.

(b) Not less than 5 (five) years experience of teaching in Secondary School/Colleges.

(c) Preference will be given to candidates having knowledge testing, evaluation and curriculum developing and expertise in teaching of Science and/or Mathematics for one of the posts, in teaching English and Lushai for the second post and in teaching History and/ or Geography for the third post.

(d) Working knowledge of Mizo is desirable qualification.

(4) Age — Not less than 30 years of age. No age restriction in case of persons already in Government service.

Basic academic qualification (but not the training qualification) and age prescribed for the posts in 1 & 2 above may be relaxed in exceptional cases for can-

didates who are otherwise fund sutable for the posts. Persons who appeared in the M.Ed. Examination under the N.E.H.U but whose results have not yet been published, may also apply for the posts provided they are otherwise qualified.

Applications on plain paper stating name, Father's name, Age, educational qualifications from HSLC/Matriculation and upwards with Divisions and subjects taken at the various levels, teaching experience etc. and full address, accompanied with attested copies of certificates in support of Educational qualifications teaching experience should reach the undersigned on or before the 31st.
