No. FOR. 15-A/77-78/4, the 31st Aug. 1977. In exercise of the powers conferred under section 6 (1) of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram is pleased to constitute Wild Life Advisory Board under the Govt. of Mizoram with the following members :-

The term, conditions and duties of the Board will be as mentioned in the Annexure - 1.

The duration will be for one year with effect from the date of issue of this notification.

#### ANNEXURE - I

Terms, conditions and duties of Wild Life Advisory Board under the Govt. of Mizoram will be as follows :-

- 1) The Board shall meet at least twice in a year.
- 2) The Board shall regulate its own procedure (including the quantum).
- 3) No act or proceeding of the Board shall be invalid merely by reason of the existence of any vacancy therein or any defect in the constitution thereof or any irregularity in the procedure of the Board, not effecting the merits of the case.
- 4) Duty of the Board is to advise the Govt. of Mizoram in the following matters :-
  - (a) in the selection of areas to be declared as sanctuaries National Parks, game reserves and closed areas and the administration thereof.
  - (b) in formulation of the policy in granting licenses and permits under the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972.
  - (c) in any matter relating to the amendment of any Schedule, and
  - (d) in any other matter connected with the protection of Wild Life, which may be referred to it by the State Government.

The non-official members of the Board are entitled to DA/TA at the rate admissible to Grade I officers to performance of the above duties.

As provided under section 7 (5) of the Lushai Hills District (Village Councils) Act, 1953, read with Rule 4 (4) of the Lushai Hills District (Administration of Justice) Rules, 1953, as adapted, the election of Shri Thansanga as Vice President of Ramblun Village Council is hereby approved with effect from 25.7.1977.
