The method of recruitment whether direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/transfer and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods as notified under this Deptt. No. MAP/B/13/72/6 dt. 10.2 1975 at sl. No 1 of the schedule under Col. 10 which read as "By direct recruitment" should be substituted as "By direct recruitment" 100% other than Peon and as for Peons - 75% by direct recruitment, 25% by transfer from Sweepers, Dak runner, Jugali, Animal attendant, Mali, and Chowkidar who do not possess the qualifications prescribed for direct recruitment to the post of Peon but who possess elementary literacy and give proof of ability to read either English or Mizo or Hindi and have put in 5 (five) year's service in the parent cadre with immediate effect-
