No. L&ED. 11/77/48, the 4th May, 1978. The Equal Remuneration Ordinance, which was promulgated by the President in September, 1975 was replaced by Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, on the 11th February, 1976. The Act provides for payment of equal remuneration to men and women workers for same work or work of similar nature and for the prevention of discrimination against women in the matter of recruitment. In terms of sections 1 (3) and 6 (1) the Act has been made applicable to almost all categories of employments and it is proposed to cover the remaining few categories as well in the near future. A list containing the employments covered by the Act is enclosed.

Of late, some instances have been brought to the notice of Government (GoI) that the provisions of the Act are not being implemented effectively and the women workers are being paid wages lower than those paid to men workers, though the job contents are same or similar.

It is therefore requested that all efforts should be made for effective implementation of the provisions of the Act.
