TERMS AND CONDITONS:

- (I) To advise in regard to preparation and implementation of State Adult Education Programme, particularly
- (a) regarding involvement of various agencies such as voluntary organisations, youth and students, employers and trade Unions;
- (b) regarding creation of an environment favourable for launching and 'implementation of a massive programme of Adult Education;
- (c) regarding resources development, in particular production of teaching learning materials and training;
- (d) regarding special measures necessary to extend this programme to women and to persons belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes;
- (e) regarding organisation of post-literacy activities by production and dissemination of literature for non-literatures, organisation of discussion and action groups etc.
- (2) To take necessary measures for coordination among various departments of Government and between departments of Govt. on the one hand and various other agencies on the other.
- (3) To oversee and evaluate from time to time the progress of preparation for launching of State Adult Education Programme and its implementation.
- (4) The frequency of the meetings of the State Board of Adult Education shall be as may be necessary, but not less than twice a year.
- (5) The M.L.A.s will be members so long as they remain members of the Assembly, or the reconstitution of the Board, whichever is earlier.
