In exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (5) of Section 8 of the Central Sales Tax Act, 1956 (Central Act 74 of 1956), the Governor of Assam, being satisfied that it is necessary to do so in the Public interest, hereby directs that with effect from 1st October, 1978, no tax under the said Act shall be payable for a period upto 31st December, 1978 by any registered dealers having his place of business in the State of Assam in respect of sales by him from any such of business of any goods in the course of inter-state trade or commerce to any registered dealer in the Union Territories of Arunachal Pradesh and Mizoram to the extent such sales are covered by clause (b) of Sub-section (1) of Section 8 of the said Act.

Whereas the Minister i/c L.A.T.P & H received complaints from the public and his Ministerial Colleagues against the Village Councils of Serchhip, Hnahthial, Khawlian, Kolasib, Ruantlang, Kawnpui and Thingdawl to the effect that these Village Councils did not function efficiently and impartially in the discharge of their duties.

And Whereas, the Cabinet in their meeting on 20th. August. 1978 has decided that these Village Councils should be dissolved for reasons as stated above;

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 25 (1) of the Lushai Hills District (Village Councils) Act, 1953, as adapted, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram is pleased to dissolve the Village Councils of Serchhip, Hnanthial, Khawlian, Kolasib, Ruantlang, Kawnpui and Thingdawl with effect from the 21st. August, 1978.

Further in exercise of the powers conferred by section 25 (2) of the same Act, the Lt. Governor of Mizoram is pleased to appoint the following Circle Assistants to assume charge of the said Village Council Adm. functions and also to function as Village Councils till further orders are issued and fresh election of General Election of Village Councils, whichever is earlier, is held.
