PRELIMINARY NOTIFICATION

No. FOR 133/78-79/43, the 27th November, '78. In exercise of the power conferred under Section 14 and 15 read with Section 16 and 17 of the MIZO DISTRICT (Forest) Act 1955 read with Section 4, 5, and 7 of the Assam Forest Regulation 1891 it is proposed to constitute the land described below as Reserve Forest, and therefore it is hereby notified that any claim of Rights on the land and any objections against the proposed Reserve Forest, shall be submitted in writing to the undersigned within 120 days from the date of publication of the notification, for disposal of such claims / objections.

From the date of issue of this Notification till the date of Final notification to be issued by the Govt. no new right of any nature shall be acquired within the land comprised in this notification; and no felling of the Forests for any purpose shall be made and no trees shall be cut or felled for the purpose of trade or manufacture without permission in writing from a competent authority.

LAND PROPOSED FOR RESERVATION :

1. MUTHI PROPOSED RESERVE FOREST BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION :

NOTH: Starting from Pillar No. 1 which is fixed on the Gardent foot path at a distance of 8.5 chains, at a bearing of 122.30' from a saddle on Durtlang - Muthi foot - path, the boundary runs towards Kawnpui Hill (Eastern Side) and just below K. Sawiluia's Ginger Garden upto Pillar No 10 and then runs towards Bote area till it reaches Bote Peng (foot-path) junctions, Pillar No. 16. Then it goes down towards the stream Damdiai (Pillar No. 18) and follows the said stream down east wards till it reaches Tuirial Reverine Reserve (Pillar No. 27).

EAST: Thence the boundary leaves Damdiai stream and follows the left side boundary of Tuirial Reverine and runs in South ward direction along a demarcated line through jaumming area till it reaches Mutnilui (stream) Pillar No. 42, thence the boundary runs along the Muthi stream upwards for about 1 ½ k.m. upto Pillar No. 45 (near Tuirial Air Field) a junction point with one unnamed small stream with Muthi Lui.

SOUTH: Thence the boundary turns towards east following the stream Muthi upward till it reaches Zuangtui lui junction with Muthi Lui (Pillar No. 63).

WEST: Thence the boundary turns North following the streamlet of Muthi Lui upward and runs along side Lalrema's sugar cane Garden till it meets the starting point (Pillar No. 1).

TREES : *Anogeisus Acuminata* (Zairum) *Muk Stores spermum cheloneides* (Zibngha) *Tueifeimung*. *Callicarpa arborea* (Hnabkiah) *Macaranga* spp (Hnabkhar) *Sebima wallichii* (Kniang) *Mesua ferrea* (Herhse) *Albizia stipulata* (Vang). *Sterculia villosa* (Khaupui) *Emblia officinels* (Sunhlu). *Machilus* spp. (Bul) *Engelhardtia* (Bungou tuairam), *Tawitaw* *Bursera serrata* (Bill) *Berawchal*, *Gmelina arborea* (Thlanvawng), *Duabanga grandiflora* (Zuang). *Castonopsis tribuleides* (Thingsia) *Thingkhualu*, *Batling*, *Ngiau* (*Michelia champaca*) etc.

BAMBOO : *Melocanna bambuseides* (Mautak) *Bambusa tulda* (Rawthing) flowered and dried. *Teinostachyum dullosa* (Rawthla), *Dendrocalamus*, *longispathus* (Rawnal) *Dendrocalamus hamiltoni* (Phulrua).

G ROUND FLORA : *Changel*, *Tiangsam* (*Eupatorium odoratum*) *Vakep* (*Mussuenda frondosa*, (*Halmthel*. *Phrynium capitatiu* (Hnabthial) *Thang* (Bamboo grass). *Luang* (*Erianthus longisetum*). *Di* (Thatch grass). *Saitil* (*Me lo calamus compactiflorus* etc).

CLIMBERS : *Mikania scandens* (Nipui), *Smilax* spp *Kawihruai*, *Hruilliao*, *Aibuh*, *Vauhrui* etc.

2. ZANLAWN TLANG PROPOSED RESERVE FOREST. BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION.

NORTH : The boundary starts from Khankawn-Tialpui farm Jeep road junction with Aizawl - Silchar main road near 47 K.M. posts of Aizawl—Silchar road at a bearing of 112 30' for a distance of 49.6 c.m. from the said post and runs along the said farm Jeep Road at a distance about 1 K.M. and then runs along side Lalrawn's Wet cultivation area and then crossing Lungvawkkuang mual and meets Serlui (Rukni) river at Pillar No.23, along a demarcated line.

EAST : Thence the boundary runs towards south along the left bank of Serlui (Rukni) till it meets the point where Zote falls into Rukni river (Pillar No. 34).

SOUTH : Thence the boundary runs along a demarcated line eastward upto Pillar No. 36 crossing Zote Lui. Thence the boundary runs along a demarcated

line at a bearing of 252 for a distance of 300 metres upto Pillar No. 38 Thence the boundary runs along the ridge of the Khawhlni tlangdung in south west direction upto Pillar No. 41. And then runs towards Khawdaikawn in about westerly direction upto Pillar No. 42 near Tawitaw I.B.

WEST : Thence the boundary runs due North for a distance of 400 metres upto Pillar No. 43 and then turns towards Southwest for a distance of 456 metres upto Pillar No. 44 fixed on Aizawl—Silchar Road near 42 K.M. post of Aizawl—Silchar Road. PROPOSED BOUNDARIES OF TAWI WILD LIFE SANCTUARY

NORTH: Starting from a point on the left bank of Tuirini River diametrically opposite to the confluence of Saibual stream with Tuirini the boundary follows along the right bank of Saibual Lul upstream upto its source. Thence the boundary runs eastward till it meets the sources of Sesihlui (stream) after crossing Mualpheng—Tawizo inter-village footpath.

EAST: Thence the boundary follows the left bank of Sesihlui downstream upto the confluence of Ramrilui with Sesihlui. Thence, the boundary follows the right bank of Ramrilui upstream upto the source and then runs southward up-hill long a demarcated line for a distances 10 chain upto Maite-Hmuntha inter-village foot-path.

SOUTH: Thence, the boundary follows the said inter-village footpath upto Hmuntha village. Thence, the boundary follows Hmuntha-Chhingchhip inter-village footpath till the footpath is crossed by Tuikumlui. Thence, the boundary follows the right bank of Tuikumlui upto its confluence with Khuailui east of Hmuntha village. Thence the boundary runs upstream along the right bank of Khuailui till it Hualtu-Tawizo inter-village footpath. Thence the boundary follows the said inter-villages footpath Southward upto Hualtu villages. Thence the boundary follows Hualtu-Khumtung inter-village footpath upto a point the left bank of the river Tuirini.

WEST: Thence, the boundary follows the left bank of Tuirini River downstream till it meets the starting point-a point diametrical opposite to the confluence and Saibual lui with Tuirini.
