No. L&ED. 16/76/66, the 19th March, 1979. Whereas an enquiry under Rule 14 of the Central Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1965,

has been held against Shri George L. Chongthu, Employment Officer, Aizawl on the charges drawn against him vide Memorandum No. L&ED. 63/76 dated 24.5.76 and a copy of the inquiry report being enclosed;

2. And whereas, on a careful consideration of the Inquiry Report aforesaid, the Lt. Governor of Mizoram agrees with the findings of the Inquiry Officer and holds that the charges under Articles I and II have been proved, but in view of the fact that Shri George L. Chongthu having convincingly shown to have given up the habit of intoxicating drinks, takes a lenient view:

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (2) of Rule 12 of the Central Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1965, the Lt. Governor of Mizoram hereby imposes the penalty of 'Censure' on the said Shri George L. Chongthu and further directs that the fact of this penalty be recorded in ACR of the officer.
