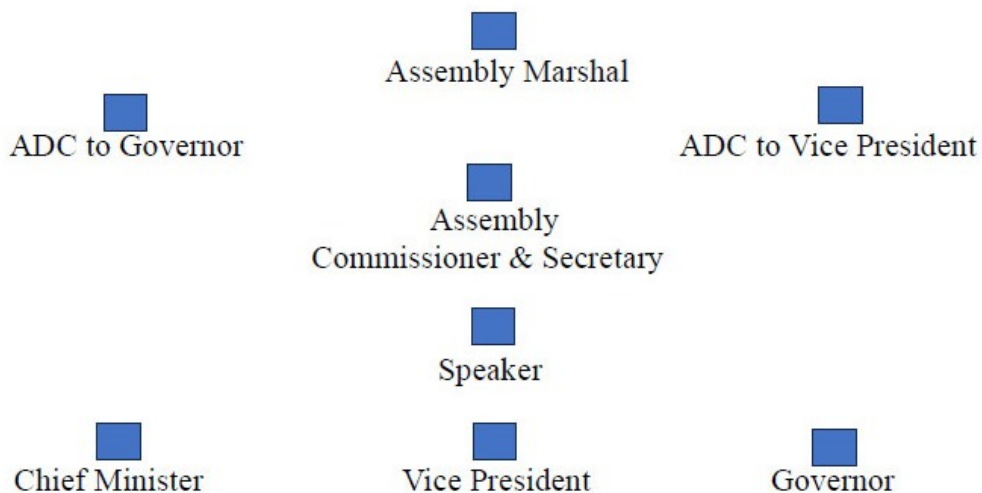

**PROGRAMME OF VICE PRESIDENT’S ADDRESS TO ASSEMBLY ON
26TH FEBRUARY, 2024**

1. Members are informed that the Hon’ble Vice President of India will address the House on 26th February, 2024 at 12:45 P.M.
2. Members are requested to be in their seats in the Session Hall at Assembly House by 12:40 P.M.
3. On arrival at the Gate of the Assembly House, the Hon’ble Vice President of India accompanied by the Hon’ble Governor of Mizoram and the Hon’ble Chief Minister will be received by the Hon’ble Speaker and Commissioner & Secretary, Mizoram Legislative Assembly. Thereafter, the Vice President will be conducted to the Assembly Hall in a ceremonial procession in the following order:



4. The Assembly Marshal will announce the arrival of the Hon'ble Vice President of India. National Anthem will be played by 23rd Sector Assam Rifle Pipe Band when the Vice President arrives at the dais. All persons will resume their seats after the Vice President takes his seat.

5. Seating arrangement of VVIPs at the podium will be in the following order:



Hon'ble Governor



Hon'ble Vice President



Hon'ble Speaker

6. The Hon'ble Speaker may give a welcome address and invite Pu Laldhuma, Hon'ble Leader of the House to make a speech. At the conclusion of the speech, the Hon'ble Leader of the House may resume his seat. The Hon'ble Speaker may invite the Hon'ble Vice President of India to address the House.

7. The Hon'ble Speaker will request all to stand up for National Anthem. The National Anthem will be played again by 23rd Sector Assam Rifle Pipe Band.

8. The Hon'ble Vice President of India may leave the House and may rest for a while in the Common Recess Room before proceeding to the Golden Jubilee Monument for group photo.
