REPORT

1. This Report of the Committee deals with Action Taken by the Government on the 3(three) recommendations contained in its Third Report relating to the Health & Family Welfare Department, which was presented to the House on the 28th of August, 2025.

3.1.1 RECOMMENDATION

The Committee recommends that a provision be included in the State Clinical Establishment Rules for furnishing Annual Report by the Council and mandatory laying of the Annual Report on the Table of the House of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly. This Annual Report is to consist of the registered and unregistered clinics under the council, actions taken by the council (and the Deputy Registering Authority), the number of meetings held, revenue generated (if any), Annual Action Plans, achievement of the previous Annual Action Plans, and other important information.

This is to ensure the accountability of the Executive to the Legislature and thus to the Public.

3.1.2 ACTION TAKEN BY THE GOVERNMENT

“The Mizoram Clinical Establishment Rules 2014 is in the process of being drafted by the Sub-Committee on 'The Mizoram Clinical Establishment (Registration & Regulation) Rules, 2014 Amendment' which was formed by the Government vide notification No.A.17014/2/2022-HFW(CEM)/98. The last meeting was held on 4th November 2025 at DHME Conference Room where the drafting is nearly completed. The next meeting is proposed to be held on 21st November 2025. The recommendation of the Subject Committee III regarding furnishing of Annual report by the Council and mandatory laying of annual report on the Table of The House of Mizoram Legislative Assembly is included in the draft amendment.”

3.1.3 FURTHER RECOMMENDATION
