to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services during the Financial Year of 2021-2022.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Seventy Third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

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| Short Title.-  | 1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (Supplementary Demand for Grants 2021-22) Act, 2022  |
| Issue of ₹ <b>602544.48 lakh</b> only out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the Financial Year, 2021-2022.- | 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied the sums not exceeding those as specified in column (5) of the Schedule to this Act, amounting, in the aggregate, to the sum of <i>Rupees six thousand twenty five crore forty four lakh forty eight thousand</i> only for defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the Financial Year, 2021-2022 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule. |
| Appropriation.-  | 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.  |
| Repeal & Saving.-  | 4. The Mizoram Appropriation (Supplementary Demand for Grants 2020-21) Act, 2021 (Act No.1 of 2021) published in the Mizoram Gazette Extraordinary Issue No.166 of dt.23.3.2021 is stand hereby repealed.  |
