- i. The work should be completed as targeted and indicated in the enclosed Technical Note.
- ii. In accordance with the order contained in the Ministry's Circular letter No. RW.NH-110267/2/99-US (D-I) dated 29.10.2001 issued in

supersession of earlier Circular No RW.NH-11026/2/99-US (D-I) dated 13.01.2000, if the cost of tender exceed 5% of the Sanctioned estimated cost, the revised estimate be got sanctioned from the Ministry. It may also be ensured that the guide lines issued by the Ministry's circular No. RW/NH-24035/4/2008-P&M/PC Vol-III dated 23.02.2018 regarding invitation of tenders for execution of works on NHs and others Centrally Financial schemes relating to Advertisement should be adhered to depending on the requirement. Further, the entire works under the job shall be executed **through contract**. The State PWD and RO, Itanagar shall ensure the tenders are **strictly invited through e-tendering** and in accordance with the procedure prescribed in the Ministry Circular No RW/NH-34066/14/2018-S&R (P&B) dated 25.06.2018. The work shall be awarded as per guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letter No NH-15015/29/2001-PL dated 05.07.2001.

- iii. On completion of 50% work, if the appraisal of the projects shows that it will necessitate revision of the estimate based upon the physical completion of the project vis-a vis financial expenditure, immediate action should be taken to submit the revised estimate, so as to ensure that the sanctioned revised estimate is available before necessity to incurring expenditure beyond permissible limits arise.

COMMENTS

1. **Scope of work:** One time improvement of bypassed road of old alignment of NH-44A(old) from i) km 27.500 to km 35.400, (ii) km 50.220 to km 70.100, (iii) km 75.000 to km 91.500 , (iv) km 105.00 to km 111.000 & km 111.250 to km 112.700 (v) km 120.240 to km 121.840 in the state of Mizoram through EPC mode.

2. The following provisions have been allowed in the estimate:-

(i) **From Km 27.500 to Km 35.400**

- a. **Jungle Clearance** (along the entire stretch)
- b. **40 mm Earthen Shoulder** (1m wide) on both sides of road for a length of 7.736 km.(to match the earthen shoulder level to the 40mm BC layer that will be provided during the repair work)
- c. **Scarifying existing Granular Surface** to a Depth of 50 mm. (about **11.51% area**)
- d. **200mm WMM** at damaged stretches and potholes. (on about **11.51% area**) of road stretch)
- e. **50mm DBM** at damaged stretches and potholes. (on about **11.51%**)
- f. **40mm BC** for a length of 7.878 km. (3.75m width)
- g. **Construction of Cement Concrete Pavement** at Km 32.200 for a length of 22m.

- h. Hill Side Drain clearance for a length of 7.780 km.
- i. Road marking (Both edge lines marking for a length of 7.9 km)
- j. Construction of Gabion wall at Km 32.200 (48mx3m)

(ii) From Km 50.220 to Km 70.100

- a. Jungle Clearance (along the entire stretch)
- b. 40 mm Earthen Shoulder (1m wide) on both sides of road for a length of 19.723 km.(to match the earthen shoulder level to the 40mm BC layer that will be provided during the repair work)
- c. 200mm WMM at damaged stretches and potholes. (on about 56.04 % paved area)
- d. 50mm DBM at damaged stretches and potholes.(on about 56.04 % paved)

- d. 50mm DBM at damaged stretches and potholes.(on about 40.19 % area)
- e. 40mm BC for a length of 16.5 km. (3.75m width)

- g. Road delineator at narrow portion (413 Nos)
- h. Road Marking.(Both edge lines marking for a length of 16.50 km)
- i. Repair of collapsed Hume pipe culvert at Km 76.05.
- j. Construction of Retaining wall at Km 76.150 (10mx1.5m), Km 76.300 (7mx1.5m), Km 76.400 (6mx1.5m), Km 77.500 (15mx1.375m) & Km 80.500 (9mx1.625m).

(iv) From Km 105.00 to Km 11.000 & Km 11.250 to Km 112.700

- a. Jungle Clearance (along the entire stretch).
- b. 40 mm Earthen Shoulder (1m wide) on both sides of road for a length of 7.394 km.(to match the earthen shoulder level to the 40mm BC layer that will be provided during the repair work)
- c. 150mm GSB at damaged stretches. (on about 66.25 % area)
- d. 200mm WMM at damaged stretches. (on about 66.25 % area)
- e. 50mm DBM at damaged stretches (on about 66.25 % area)
- f. 40 mm BC for a length of 7.45 km.(3.75m width)
- g. Hill Side Drain clearance for a length of 7.394 km.

- b. Road delineator at narrow portion (75 Nos).
- i. Road Marking (Both edge lines marking for a length of 7.45 km)
- j. Construction of Retaining wall at 105.200 Km (12.38mx1.5m), 106.500 Km (10mx1.35m), 107.300 Km (10mx1.135m), 107.900 Km (7mx1.65m), 108.250 Km (6mx1.65m), 109.230 Km (4mx1.75m), 109.850 Km (4mx1.75m) & 111.950 Km (15mx2.125m).

(v) From Km 120.240 to Km 121.840

- a. Jungle Clearance (along the entire stretch).
- b. 80 mm Earthen Shoulder (1m wide) on both sides of road for a length of 1.588 km.
- c. 200mm WMM at damaged stretches and potholes.(on about 14.88 % area)
- d. 50mm DBM at damaged stretches and potholes.(on about 14.88 % area)
- e. 40 mm BC for the entire stretch of 1.6 km. (3.75m width)
- f. Hill Side Drain clearance for a length of 1.588 km.
- g. Road marking.(Both edge lines marking for a length of 1.6 km)

3. Comments/Modification:

- 3.1 The centages has been corrected applying only on civil construction costs per Ministry circular dated 09.03.2019.
- 3.2 Maintenance charge is reduced from 2.5% to 1% (of Civil Cost plus GST) as the Maintenance period is taken as 3 years.
- 3.3 Price escalation is taken as 2.5 % as the construction period is 18 months.
- 3.4 Supervision charge is reduced from 3% to 1 % as per Ministry latest guideline.

4. Miscellaneous

- 4.1 **Centages:-** Provision of Contingency @1%, labour cess @ 1%, agency charges @3%, GST @18%, Supervision Charges of 1% and Maintenance charge 1 % have been allowed.
- 4.2 Construction period for this work shall be **18 months** including the rainy period. The Defect Liability period/Maintenance period shall be **3 years** as mentioned in EPC document. Further, the State PWD shall ensure that the bonus clause is deleted from the EPC agreement.
- 4.3 Price escalation has been considered @ 2.5% as the Construction period is 18 months.
- 4.4 State PWD may ensure that work is physically completed as per proposed scope of work and monitored timely to avoid cost and time overrun.

5. Rates & Leads:-

- 5.1 As reported by State PWD the rates adopted in this estimate are as per the Schedule of Rates 2023 for National Highways & State Roads in Mizoram. The rates in the SOR are exclusive of Labour Cess (@1%) and

inclusive of GST (@18%).

- 5.2 It is presumed that while forwarding the proposal, Chief Engineer, Highways, Mizoram has satisfied himself about the adequacy & workability and correctness of the rates and leads, respectively adopted for formulation of the estimate.

6. Invitation of tenders and award of works:

- 6.1 RFP and draft contract documents to be adopted as per the latest draft Model RFP and EPC documents approved by the Ministry (March 2019) after making project specific changes as well as amendments circulated by Ministry.
- 6.2 The bids for the work should be invited through e-tendering system as per the instructions issued vide Ministry's guidelines.
- 6.3 The advertisement for invitation of tenders shall be done as per Ministry's letter No. RW/NH-34066/14/2018-S&R(R&B) dated 25.06.2018.
- 6.4 CVC guidelines in tendering shall be followed.
- 6.5 In accordance with the orders contained in this Ministry's letter No.24035 /4/2008-P&M/PIC Vol.II dated 23.2.2018, if the cost of tender exceeds 5% of sanctioned estimated cost, the revised estimate be got sanctioned from the Ministry and all the works above Rs.5.00 crore are mandatory to be taken up on EPC mode and works less than Rs.5.00 crore may be on SBD/EPC mode. Further, the instructions contained in the Ministry's circular letter No RW/NH-33044/12/2019-S&R(P&B) dated 24.03.2019 would be ensured while accepting tenders.
- 6.6 The work is to be awarded within six months from the date of issue of sanction. In this connection, the Ministry's Circular No. RW/NH-24035/4/2008-P&M/PIC Vol.II dated 23.02.2018 is to be referred. If the work is not awarded within the stipulated time, it may lead to de-sanction of the work unless Ministry's prior approval to extension of sanction validity is obtained.

7. General:

- 7.1 The work shall be executed as per provisions in Model Engineering Procurement and Construction (EPC) document dated 05.03.2019 and subsequent amendments made thereon. All schedules required for EPC mode of execution of work shall be in line with approved estimate and technical note. State PWD shall ensure to remove all encroachment of ROW and site shall be provided to the agency free from all encumbrances.
- 7.2 The schedule and EPC documents shall be finalized by Chief Engineer, PWD Highways, Mizoram in consultation with R.O. Guwahati as per extant guidelines before inviting tenders. RO Guwahati shall ensure that all the provisions of the estimate and the requirements of the project have been duly incorporated in the respective schedule.
- 7.3 Wherever applicable, IRC-guidelines shall be followed.
- 7.4 The work is to be carried out in accordance with Ministry's Specifications for Road & Bridge Works (5th Revision), 2013 and the "Manual for quality control in Road & Bridge Works- IRC SP 112-2017", observing strict quality control instructions contained in the Ministry's letter RW/NH-34066/01/2020-QCZ dated 1.10.2020. RO, MORT&H, Guwahati may get necessary testing done for quality control of the work.
- 7.5 No work beyond the scope of the sanctioned estimate leading to increase in the scope of the work or change in specification should be undertaken without obtaining prior written approval of the Ministry. In

- case, the estimate needs revision due to change in rates/tender rates for any reasons, the revised estimate shall be submitted immediately for Ministry's approval. No expenditure beyond permissible delegation (as per policy guidelines) should be incurred.
- 7.6 Neither the work nor any item of work shall be split into small parts for awarding the work to a number of contractors. In case splitting is necessary due to prevailing conditions, it should be done only after prior approval of this Ministry.
 - 7.7 Display boards on development activities of the work shall be made as per guidelines issued by Ministry.
 - 7.8 For maintenance of proper record of the execution of the work Photography/videography shall be taken by state PWD before, during and after execution of work and a digital copy of the same may be forwarded to Ministry/RO Guwahati for record.
 - 7.9 Collection of material on the roadside should be so planned that it should commensurate with the physical progress of work and the collected material should not cause any hindrance to the traffic. It must be ensured that the contractor arranges for separate land for storage of road construction material and machinery and these shall not be allowed to be stacked on roadside.
 - 7.10 Guidelines for Road Safety vide Ministry's letter No.RW/NH-29011/01/2015-P&M(RSCE) dated 20.09.2019 shall be followed.
 - 7.11 The transverse bars marking may be provided at identified accident prone spots and at junctions where the need for alerting drivers/reduction in speed desired as per Ministry circular no. RW/NH/33044/13/2012-S&R (R) dated 04.05.2013. This should be included in Schedule C of EPC Agreement.
 - 7.12 In order to ensure that there is no slippage in achieving the targets, the progress may be closely monitored by competent authority and monthly status should be updated on PMIS.
 - 7.13 The provisions made in the estimate are accepted for estimate purpose only. Any savings (in the provisions in the estimate) during execution of the work shall be credited to the estimate.
 - 7.14 The estimates for carrying out the activities under the provision of contingencies including change in scope of work will be approved by Ministry on assurance/certification by Authority's Engineer/CE (NH), PWD Department that the amount provided against contingencies is available and the same has not been indirectly utilized by accepting higher tender rates. Authority's Engineer/CE (NH), PWD Department shall also certify that approval of estimates to be charged to contingencies will not cause revision of the sanctioned estimate.
 - 7.15 The provision of Project contingencies and agency charges should be utilized as per Ministry's circular letter no. RW/NH-24035/4/2008-P&M/PIC Vol-II dated 23.02.2018. For any other item, which is not covered in the above circular necessary approval of Ministry (in principle) with the recommendation of Concerned RO should be taken before execution. However, sub-estimate for the same should be got approved from Concerned RO, before execution.
 - 7.16 During construction work, proper arrangement for smooth flow of the traffic may be ensured by providing adequate traffic control devices in accordance with stipulations of IRC: SP:55-2014 and traffic operation to be regulated causing least inconvenience to road user. Traffic management should be done as per clause 112 of Ministry's specification, during the construction period it may be insured that the

traffic is regulated in conformity to Ministry's guidelines stipulated in clause No.8.2.3 'Manual for construction and supervision of bituminous work..".

- 7.17 Condition of the road should be recorded by Network Survey vehicle in accordance with Ministry's Circular No. RW/NH-33044/32/2019-S&R(P&B) dated 13.11.2019.
- 7.18 The provision of Road Safety furniture are allowed as per estimate purpose only. RO, Guwahati shall ensure the adequacy of Road Safety items before the award of the work. Crash barriers should be installed as per guidelines given in IRC-119-2015. Any additional cost from this may be met with contingency cost.
- 7.19 Waste Plastic shall be utilized in wearing coat in stage strengthening works in projects near urban area and other feasible stretches in accordance to Ministry circular No. RW-NH-33044/24/2015-S&R (R) dated 09.11.2015 and 27.12.2016. Also, instruction issued vide circular No. RW-NH-33044/24/2015-S&R (R) dated 27.08.2019 regarding "Collection and reuse of waste plastic" may also be complied with.
- 7.20 The provisions for road markings have been allowed as proposed. The road markings may be provided as per IRC: 35, 2015. The work of road marking with stipulated paint (Thermoplastic) shall be done as per Cl. 803 of Ministry's latest specifications.
